STEP 1

Schedule an appointment.

STEP 2

Prepare to come in to answer a few questions, learn about the program and other services you may qualify for.

(If ineligible, applicant is referred to other resources.)

STEP 3

Get help with admissions and enrolling in a career program that fits the kind of job you are looking for. If already enrolled, stop by and see if you qualify for support services to stay enrolled.

(Receive support services.)

Such as: Tuition, Fees, Books, Uniforms, Equipment, Tools, and Transportation Assistance

STEP 4

While enrolled, keep your college course grades up by making a grade of "C" or better. Services include: Career Counseling, One on One Advising & Breaking Barrier Sessions.

STEP 5

While enrolled in your college program, get help with finding a good paying job. Services include: interviewing skills, resume writing, and how to dress for success.
